POSITION DESCRIPTION

Reporting into the Facilities Manager, the Mechanic's primary role with Longview Farms will be to perform troubleshooting, repairs and ongoing maintenance of farm equipment and vehicles.

LOCATION

Victoria (Central Saanich), British Columbia

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Under the direct supervision of the Facilities Manager and Head Grower, performs routine maintenance on heavy-duty mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, and diesel systems on a variety of farming equipment and vehicles.
- Adjusts equipment and repairing/replacing defective parts, components or systems using hand and power tools.
- Maintains service documentation when necessary and ordering required parts from vendors.
- Ensures appropriate equipment and tools are maintained and in good operating condition.
- Stays current on new equipment trends and making recommendations for change as appropriate.
- Assists with any additional duties, as requested by the Grower, Maintenance worker or General Manager of the farm.
- Fosters a positive and healthy work environment through continuous involvement with and adherence to all WCB and Corporate Safety Programs and improved working relationships with all employees.

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS

- Red Seal Certification as a Mechanic.
- 2 + years of experience with repairing and maintaining vehicles and equipment.
- Class 5 driver's license with a clean abstract.
- Class 1 or 3 driver's license is considered an asset.
- Mechanical background knowledge, particularly with various engines and farming equipment.
- Skill in diagnosing faults or malfunctions using computerized and other testing equipment to determine the extent of repair required.
- Understanding of schematics and diagrams.
- Knowledge of farming and construction equipment.
- High degree of independent judgment.
- Willing to occasionally travel to job sites (nearby farms and properties), as necessary (required)
- Owning tools applicable for the position is considered an asset.
- Occupational First Aid Certification.
- Forklift experience.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

- MS office skills; including, Word, Excel, and Outlook.
- Able to walk, stand, kneel, lift 50 lbs., and perform other physical duties for long periods for long hours in inclement weather conditions.
